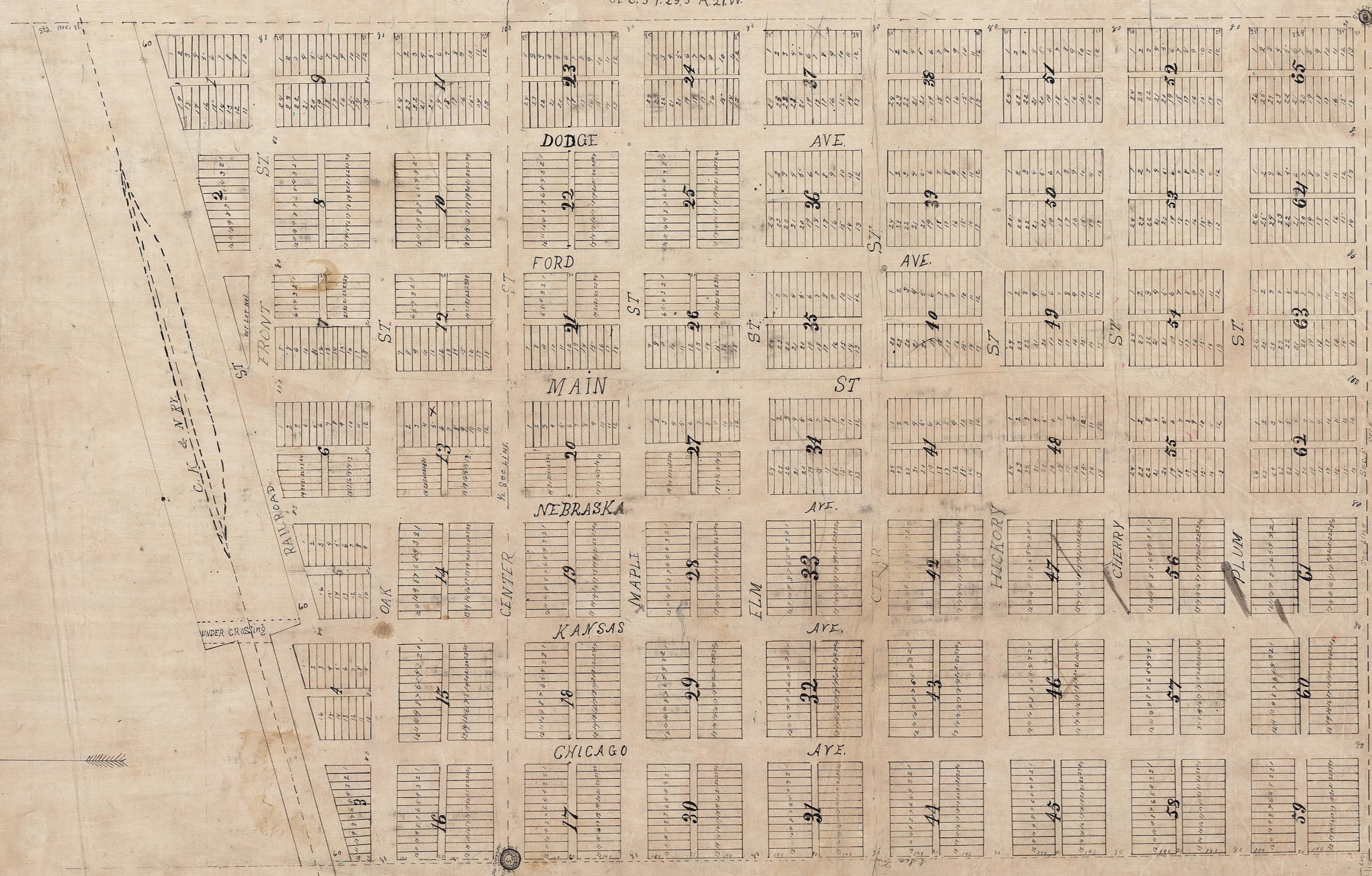

at a regular meeting of the Board of Co. Commissioners July 8th 1887 the following action was had in regard to a petition to vacate certain blocks streets and alleys in the town of Bucklin.

A petition was presented to the Board by the owners of the property hereinafter described, praying the Board to make an order vacating the following described Lots Block streets and alleys belonging to the town of Bucklin all Lots in Blocks Thirty eight (38) Thirty nine (39) Forty (40) Forty one (41) Forty two (42) Forty three (43) Forty four (44) Forty five (45) Forty six (46) Forty seven (47) Forty eight (48) Forty nine (49) Fifty (50) Fifty one (51) Fifty two (52) Fifty three (53) Fifty four (54) Fifty five (55) Fifty six (56) Fifty seven (57) Fifty eight (58) Fifty nine (59) Sixty (60) Sixty one (61) Sixty two (62) Sixty three (63) Sixty four (64) Sixty five (65) and all alleys in said Blocks, all of Plains Cherry & Hick Streets and the south Fifty feet (50) of Cedar Street also all that portion of Chicago, Kansas, Nebraska, Ford and Dodge Avenues and Main Street lying south of a line Fifty feet (50) south from the north line of Cedar Street all of said Lots Block streets and alleys

being the same as all designated on the plat of said town
